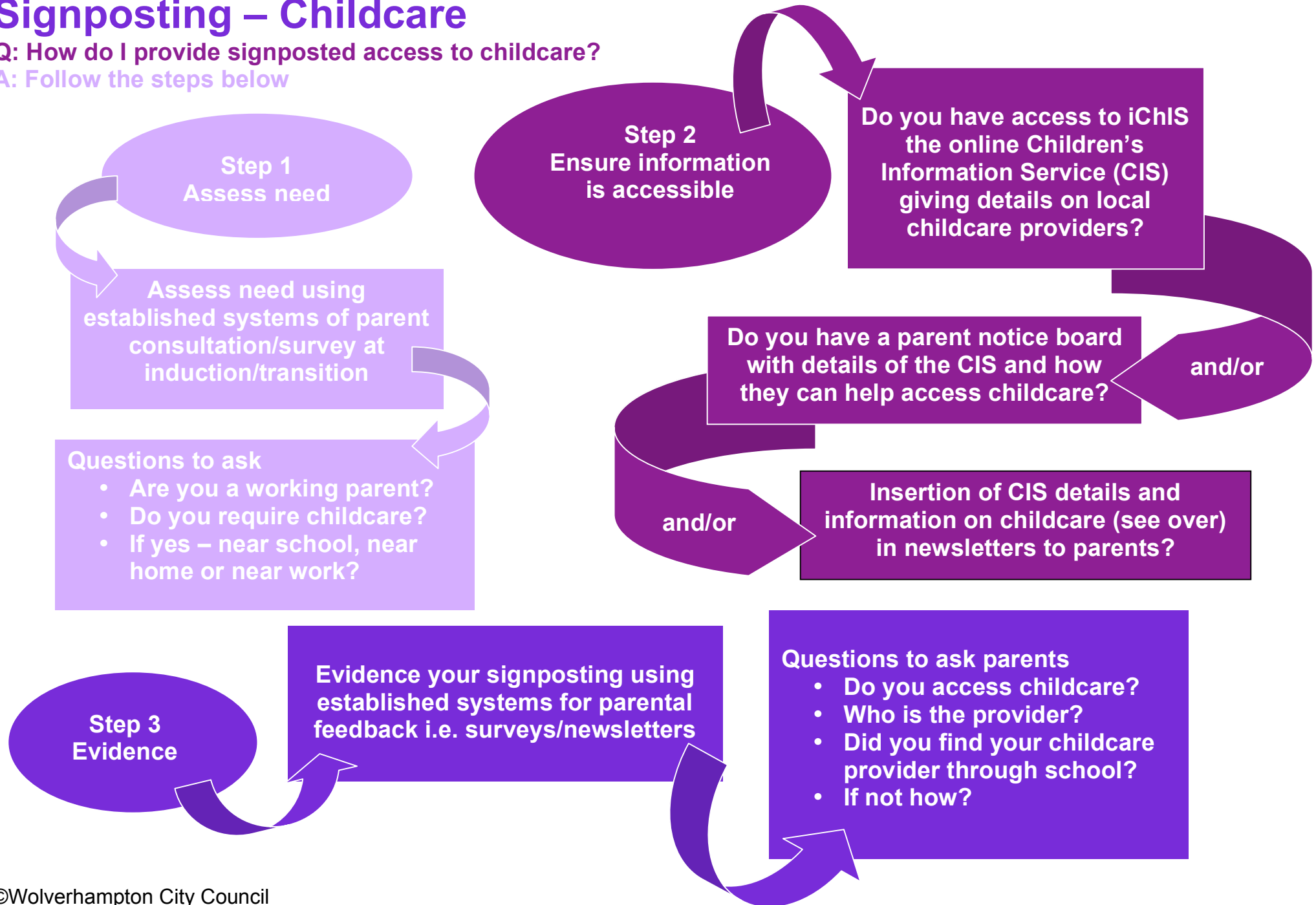


Signposting – Childcare

Out of School Childcare

Out of School Clubs offer childcare that is paid for, for children aged 3 to 14 years (16 years where a child has special needs)

- Clubs can be operated in schools, managed by the Governing Body or by a private provider. They can be off site e.g. in community centres or private day care settings, managed privately or by a voluntary management committee.
- The childcare offered can include breakfast clubs, after school clubs, full day holiday playschemes and wraparound childcare which extends the nursery day before, after and during lunchtime.
- Out of school clubs offer children a wide range of play opportunities, organised activity sessions and a quiet area for homework or for rest.

The Children's Information Service is a central, confidential access point, providing free and impartial information on a wide range of quality and affordable childcare, as well as other children's services available within the city of Wolverhampton.
